Sonal reads Board Bill 3.04 aloud in its entirety.

Nandana thanks **Sonal** for her hard work and patience on this project.

Sonal explains that because of setbacks and the painters' availability, the re-painting of the ASUW office spaces may happen during a portion of the school year.

Nandana says if **Sonal** needs support for how to plan this, let her know.

Sonal says while they may not be able to paint individual offices because of this delay, they can still make other updates to the office spaces' appearances.

Audriana asks when the painting will be done.

Sonal says the painting will start next week, but it may not be done until the end of September.

Owen asks if the BOD will still be in the office on Monday to move stuff around for the painters.

Sonal says, yes, they will need to move furniture and take stuff off the wall, but she is not sure if it will be on Monday yet.

Owen says they can work to figure that out. He suggests moving furniture around after their meeting today.

Sonal says **Grace** has disconnected from the Zoom, meaning the Board has lost quorum. She says they will take a brief recess until **Grace** can reconnect.

Nandana says **Grace** has reconnected all calls the meeting back to order.

Owen asks if they should move the couches out of the office now.

Discussion Items

Nandana says they will now give brief board updates.

Audriana explains that she has created a new partnership with the Health Science Organization Program. She says they are holding three vaccine clinics in the UW area in September. She explains ASUW is partnering with them to give uninsured students free vaccines. She adds that she will bring a Board Bill at the next meeting requesting around

\$10,000 for this initiative. She explains that LiveWell wants to create care packages twice this year, once in October, and another one after Spring Break.

Owen explains he has been working on finishing up hirings and planning ASUW orientation.

Nandana explains that she has met with almost everyone she will work with this year. She adds that she has also met with OGR to plan city council lobbying. She says that she wants to lobby for public safety this year. She explains that she recently met with the UW President, Provost, and the VP of Student Life.

Valeria explains she has been connecting JCC leaders with resources and advisors. She says she has been talking with **Brandon** about creating a bill focused on divestment from unethical companies.

Ashwin explains he has continued reading the ASUW Constitution. He says he is excited to be back on campus soon.

Sonal says she has continued planning orientation with **Owen**. She says that things have been going smoothly so far. She adds that there will be a new Senate presentation and event workshop during orientation this year. She explains that this next week, she will work with **Owen** on an alternate ASUW orientation for people who can't make it in person. She says she will be creating a "Meet the BOD" for the beginning of orientation and sending it out very soon.

Grace explains that she has been working with **Renee** on the event planning workshop for orientation. She adds that she has also been planning the RSO Leadership Summit. She says an outdoor husky hangout Dawg Daze event will take place on September 23, and a formal ASUW meet-and-greet event will take place on September 25.

Nandana explains that the hours page is still down. She asks for BOD members to keep track of their summer hours on a sheet or in a note. She explains they want to set a good standard for tracking hours when other employees start after orientation.

Sonal says if anyone has additional questions about orientation to please let her know. She urges every Board member to be present at orientation.

Nandana agrees and says it is very important for Board members to be at orientation. She adds that BOD orientation is on September 13.

Nandana explains that WSA's vote summit was a few weeks ago. She thanks **Valeria** and **Audriana** for attending. She explains that the next event, WSA's Fall General Assembly, will be when they set WSA's legislative agenda for the academic year. She says if they have agenda items they'd like to lobby for statewide, please let her know ASAP. She says a date has not been confirmed, but they are thinking around November 1. She explains that if BOD has anything they want to see on ASUW legislative agenda, to let **Brandon**, the Director of Legislative Affairs, know.

Nandana says they will have one more board meeting prior to orientation.
