BOARD BILL 2.17: An Act to Hire Jacquelyn Symbol-Archie as the Arts and Entertainment Director for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

WHEREAS: Jacquelyn Symbol-Archie has demonstrated exceptional leadership and vision as the current ASUW Arts + Entertainment Director, overseeing the office's programming, staff management, and operational strategy while guiding the Marketing Coordinator, Program Coordinator, and Multimedia Designer in executing a diverse portfolio of campus events that reflect student interests and contemporary cultural trends; and,

WHEREAS: Through her continued involvement with ASUW Arts + Entertainment—including previous roles as Marketing Coordinator and Lead Volunteer—Jacquelyn has developed deep institutional knowledge of the office's programming processes, event logistics, and promotional strategies, enabling her to effectively coordinate large-scale events, manage volunteer teams, and maintain strong continuity within the organization; and,

WHEREAS: Jacquelyn's background in visual storytelling, digital marketing, branding, and media production, combined with her commitment to building authentic connections within the music and arts landscape, positions her to continue strengthening Arts + Entertainment's relationships with campus partners, artists, and industry professionals while advancing creative programming that enriches the University of Washington student experience.
