BOARD BILL 2.18: An Act to Hire Pascal Diamond as the Rainy Dawg Radio General Manager for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

WHEREAS: Pascal Diamond brings direct experience within Rainy Dawg Radio as a current DJ and former Engagement Intern, demonstrating a strong understanding of the station's programming, culture, and operational structure—experience that equips them to effectively guide station development, support DJs, and serve as a knowledgeable liaison between Rainy Dawg Radio and the ASUW; and,

WHEREAS: Through their role as Social Media Operations Fellow for the investigative journalism nonprofit More Perfect Union, Pascal developed an organizational system cataloguing over 1,000 digital media assets and collaborated in media strategy sessions—demonstrating strong organizational ability, digital communications skills, and strategic thinking essential for tracking listenership trends, managing station communications, and supporting promotional initiatives; and,

WHEREAS: Pascal's extensive experience in outreach, public speaking, event organization, and advocacy—including co-founding Period Bozeman and organizing community campaigns—combined with their strong budgeting, research, and communication skills, positions them to build relationships with campus partners and local organizations, lead strategic planning for the station, and support Rainy Dawg Radio's continued growth as a creative and collaborative platform within the University of Washington community.

WHEREAS: As a Programming Intern with Compass Housing Alliance, Pascal led weekly educational programming, coordinated activities within organizational budgets, delegated responsibilities among colleagues, and served as an information conduit between teams and management—demonstrating leadership, collaboration, and operational coordination directly aligned with supervising Rainy Dawg staff, facilitating meetings, and managing day-to-day station operations; and,

THAT: Pascal Diamond be hired for the 2026-2027 Academic Year; and,
