### **BOARD BILL 2.30: An Act to Hire Jace Dixey as Bike Shop Mechanic for the 2026-2027 Academic Year**

**WHEREAS:** Jace Dixey has demonstrated a comprehensive and hands-on bicycle mechanical skillset through his personal repair experience, having performed a wide range of services including brake bleeds, derailleur adjustments, cable housing replacement, crank and bottom bracket regrease and install, fork lower service, fork seal replacement, shock seal service, wheel truing, and more — providing the foundational technical knowledge needed to perform quality repairs on customer bikes and support the shop's service queue; and,

**WHEREAS:** Jace's experience as Producer of Good Morning Inglemoor, where he managed a student team to plan, script, film, and edit weekly episodes on tight deadlines while mentoring peers and overseeing creative direction and production timelines, demonstrates the organizational discipline, leadership, and communication skills needed to work collaboratively with the Head Mechanic and Operations Manager, contribute to weekly all-staff meetings, and help keep the shop floor running smoothly and efficiently; and,

**WHEREAS:** Jace's background coaching youth soccer at Life is a Kick, where he created age-appropriate practice plans, adapted activities in real time based on participant needs, and built strong rapport with young athletes, reflects the patience, communication ability, and teaching orientation that are essential for educating UW community members on how to repair and maintain their own bicycles and delivering quality customer service to walk-in patrons of all experience levels; and,

**WHEREAS:** Jace's ongoing work as a Soccer Referee with the East King County Soccer Referee Association, where he applies rules consistently, collaborates with fellow officials, and maintains professionalism and composure under pressure from players, coaches, and spectators, combined with his 4.0 GPA in the UW College of Engineering, reflects the accountability, attention to detail, and commitment to standards that will allow him to uphold ASUW Bike Shop policies, maintain accurate records and inventory, and contribute positively to the shop's team environment.
