BOARD BILL 2.36 An Act to Hire Lizbeth Delgado as Latine Student Commission Director for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

WHEREAS: Lizbeth Delgado has developed direct and proven institutional knowledge of the Latine Student Commission through her current role as Development & Outreach Intern, where she has created S.E.E.D. scholarship campaigns for undocumented students, designed LSC graphic materials for audience engagement events, researched and secured partnerships for the Unity Day Event, and developed community programming including a Know Your Rights event that raised awareness among 300 participants and highlighted 30+ on-campus organizations and legal services — providing her with the operational familiarity, community relationships, and programmatic continuity needed to step into the Director role and advance the commission's ongoing efforts; and,

WHEREAS: Lizbeth's consistent record of high-impact, results-oriented work is demonstrated across every role she has held — from earning Dean's List recognition with a 3.87 GPA at the Foster School of Business, to placing second in the Business Bridge economic empowerment proposal for Seattle's BIPOC youth and small businesses, to championing the Freshman Track at the Russell Investments International Case Competition — reflecting the drive, follow-through, and accountability that will allow her to meet the commission's demanding responsibilities including 19 office hours per week, quarterly reporting, budget oversight, and the coordination of flagship programs such as the Dream Banquet Fundraiser and Scholarship Committee; and,

WHEREAS: Lizbeth's extensive experience communicating across diverse communities is demonstrated through her bilingual Spanish-English client support at Delgado Trucking LLC, her volunteer and ambassador work with TRIO Upward Bound serving first-generation and low-income students, her co-creation of Nuestra Raices mentoring middle schoolers across three schools, and her years of involvement with the Kent Latino Club organizing large-scale cultural events including annual Posadas for 100+ community members — equipping her with the cultural competency, empathy, and communication skills needed to serve as an effective liaison between Latine and Chicanx students, campus organizations, faculty, and the broader ASUW body; and,

WHEREAS: Lizbeth's hands-on experience in budgeting, logistics, outreach, and organizational collaboration — including preparing payroll and financial reports for 10+ employees at Delgado Trucking, conducting donor outreach for a \$6,000–\$8,000 fundraiser with Undergraduate Women in Business, leading corporate sponsorship outreach for the MOSAIC Case Competition, and coordinating multi-organization partnerships through the Undergraduate Business Council — positions her to oversee the commission's annual budget, maintain financial records, initiate necessary operational paperwork, and build the cross-campus coalitions essential to the Latine Student Commission's mission and unity within the ASUW.
