BOARD BILL 2.46: An act to Hire Evan Wangelin as Rainy Dawg Radio Music Director for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

WHEREAS: Evan Wangelin has demonstrated direct leadership and operational experience within the Rainy Dawg Radio community through his role as President of UW MUSIC, where he managed the club, coordinated on-campus events, and led weekly meetings — providing him with the institutional familiarity, station culture awareness, and collaborative leadership foundation needed to oversee Specialty Music Leads, assist DJs with show development, coordinate overnight and weekend playlists, and serve as a reliable resource for staff and volunteers across the station; and,

WHEREAS: Evan's technical background in Informatics at the University of Washington, including coursework in Data Structures and Algorithms and full-stack development experience building Hi-Fi Wifi at DubHacks — where he led a team of four and developed both front-end and Android applications — combined with his certificate in machine learning through Interactive Intelligence and his proficiency in organizing and publishing digital content through his Boom Learning internship, reflects the database management, digital organization, and technical attentiveness needed to catalog incoming music, maintain the station's physical and digital music library, manage the music server, and work alongside the Technology Manager on music database upkeep; and,

WHEREAS: Evan's experience as a solo game developer for his Senior Project, where he utilized FL Studio for music production alongside Unity, Blender, and GoDot to develop a full game demo, combined with his demonstrated awareness of music industry tools and his involvement across creative and technical disciplines, reflects the genuine passion for music and cross-disciplinary curiosity needed to establish and maintain relationships with record labels and independent promotions companies, report music industry happenings to the Rainy Dawg management team, oversee artist booking for Birthday Fest and The Kennel, and keep DJs informed and educated about new music available on the system; and,

WHEREAS: Evan's record of leadership, project management, and community service — including earning Eagle Scout through the Boy Scouts of America where he led younger scouts

as Senior Patrol Leader and executed a community Eagle Scout Project, leading STEM activities for youth at Steve & Kate Summer Camp, and being selected from 400+ applicants for the Young Executives of Color program where he presented group projects in a professional environment — demonstrates the organizational discipline, communication skills, and commitment to community that will allow him to hire and coordinate Specialty Music Leads, collaborate with the General Manager and Assistant Manager on station meetings and promotional events, and contribute meaningfully to the long-term development and positive reputation of Rainy Dawg Radio.
