BOARD BILL 3.101 An Act to Fund the Travel for PISACON

WHEREAS, the Pacific Islander Student Alliance Conference (PISACON) will take place at Oregon State University from March 20–22, bringing together Pacific Islander college students from across the region to build community, leadership, and cultural exchange;

WHEREAS, the PISC Director serves as a student leader and member of the PISACON Council and has been actively involved in preparing to host students attending the conference;

WHEREAS, due to prior commitments the Director will be unable to attend the conference in person but intends to send interns as proxies to ensure continued representation and participation in conference activities;

WHEREAS, the anticipated cost of conference registration is \$150 per attendee for three attendees, totaling \$450 if registration is completed by March 6, after which the registration fee will increase to \$200 per person;

WHEREAS, the anticipated cost of hotel accommodations is \$420 per room for two nights, with two rooms required, totaling \$840;

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost for conference registration and accommodations is \$1,290;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS

THAT: The ASUW Finance and Budget Director, Khushi Loomba, shall transfer \$1,290 from the ASUW General Fund to support conference registration and lodging for student representatives attending the Pacific Islander Student Alliance Conference (PISACON) at Oregon State University from March 20–22; and

THAT: The appropriate ASUW administrative offices work to coordinate registration and lodging accommodations as soon as possible to secure the lowest available costs for the ASUW; and

THAT: The designated student representatives attending PISACON participate in conference programming and represent the University of Washington community through engagement in leadership development, cultural exchange, and networking opportunities; and

THAT: A copy of this bill be forwarded to Tapuina Logotala, ASUW Pacific Islander Student Director, Marshall Traverse, Director SAO; Trevor Hunt, Associate Director, HUB Finance and Business Operation; Carrie Moore, HUB Director.
