BOARD BILL 3.102 An Act to Expand the Pregnancy Test Access Project

WHEREAS: ASUW Board Bill 3.21, passed on December 4th, 2025, allocated \$3,000 to provide free pregnancy tests to University of Washington students through the Pregnancy Test Access Project; and

WHEREAS: The ASUW aims to ensure that our resources are the most accessible to students in any campus community, thus collaborating with different residential groups and campus partners; and,

WHEREAS: Over 60% of the pregnancy tests allocated from last quarter have been utilized as intended through distribution from the SARVA Office, ASUW 121 Office, GWSS Advising Office, UW Food Pantry [2]; and,

WHEREAS: The Pregnancy Test Access Project plans to expand to four new distribution sites in Spring Quarter: the Oliver (Formerly Willow) and Lander Desks, the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life (OFSL), and the Ethnic Cultural Center (ECC); and,

WHEREAS: The UW Food Pantry, and the new distribution site locations will remain open during the summer quarter, ensuring that students will continue to access this resource after spring quarter ends; and

WHEREAS: This project has seen cross-organization contributions from the Gender Equity Commission, Queer Student Commission, SARVA, and Office of Student Health Relations, in addition to the founding RSOs WE Care and Huskies for Reproductive Freedom, showing that this is both an important project to this organization and an essential need for students on campus[1];

WHEREAS: The tracking of usage and distribution requirements described in Board Bill 3.21 have been fulfilled by the relevant parties and will continue as such in Spring and Summer Quarter;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

THAT: the ASUW Finance and Budget Director shall transfer \$4,000 from the ASUW General Fund to purchase more pregnancy tests to offer at no cost to students through spring and summer quarters; and

THAT: The ASUW Director of Programming will coordinate the distribution of pregnancy tests in partnership with WE CARE, Huskies for Reproductive Freedom, and the ASUW Commissions listed above; and

THAT: ASUW will continue providing pregnancy tests to students at the ASUW Main Office, ASUW SARVA Office, Gender and Women's Sexuality Studies Advising Office, and the UW Food Pantry; and

THAT: ASUW will begin providing pregnancy tests at the Oliver (formerly Willow) and Lander desks, the Ethnic Cultural Center, and the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life; and

THAT: The ASUW Director of Programming, in coordination with the ASUW Office of Communications, will update any preexisting marketing materials to accurately reflect the locations of pregnancy test sites to ensure accessible, student usage can expand accordingly; and

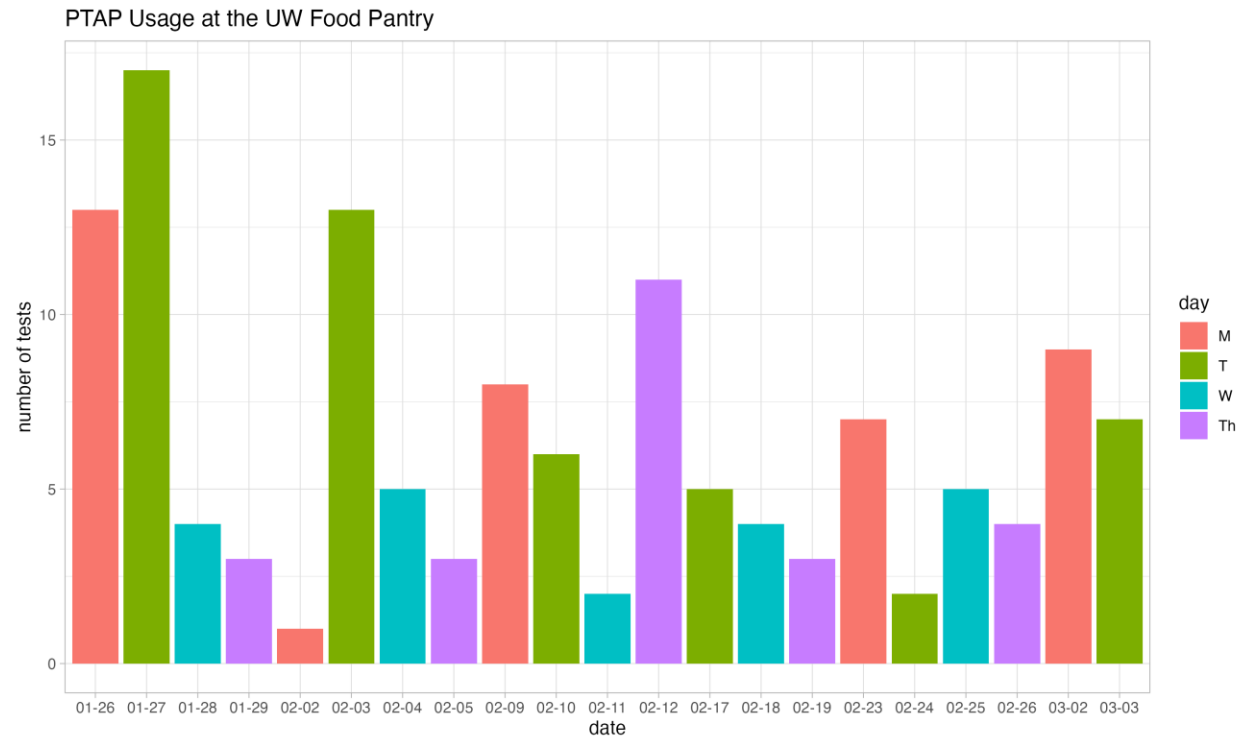
