BOARD BILL 3.179 An Act to Allocate Funding for LiveWell Care Kit Replenishment

WHEREAS: The Associated Students of the University of Washington (ASUW) is committed to supporting the health, safety, and well-being of all students through accessible wellness resources and harm reduction initiatives; and,

WHEREAS: The LiveWell Care Kits provide students with free and accessible health and safety supplies including emergency contraception, dental dams, sanitary wipes, at-home UTI tests, Naloxone, condoms, and more; and,

WHEREAS: This past Winter Quarter, LiveWell hosted a “Nuts & Bolts” session with Panhellenic Sorority Chapters, where LiveWell distributed “Chapter Care Kits” to all Panhellenic Chapters; and,

WHEREAS: LiveWell has additionally distributed variously themed Care Kits, from destressing to better sleep, to other campus communities and the general student population; and,

WHEREAS: Student feedback forms, direct statements from Chapter leadership and members, and continued demand for these resources demonstrate a clear and ongoing need for expanded access to preventative and harm reduction supplies on campus; and,

WHEREAS: The replenishment of these supplies is necessary to ensure all students across campus, particularly those within the sorority community, continue to have equitable access to essential wellness and harm reduction resources regardless of financial, medical, or logistical barriers to obtaining these items independently; and,

WHEREAS: Concerns regarding the potential misuse of emergency contraception products have highlighted the need for additional educational outreach regarding proper usage and responsible distribution practices; and,

WHEREAS: ASUW and LiveWell intend to accompany the replenishment of these resources with an educational campaign, including informational infographics and outreach materials regarding the proper use of Plan B and other wellness supplies;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

THAT: The ASUW allocates \$2,000 from the general fund to support the replenishment of LiveWell Chapter Care Kits and other Care Kits for the remainder of the academic year; and,

THAT: This funding will support the purchase and distribution of wellness and harm reduction supplies including emergency contraception, dental dams, sanitary wipes, at-home UTI tests, Naloxone, and other related resources as determined necessary by program coordinators; and,

THAT: The allocated funding will additionally support educational outreach efforts, including informational campaigns and infographics promoting safe, informed, and proper use of emergency contraception and wellness resources; and,

THAT: The ASUW Director of Community Relations and LiveWell Coordinators will monitor this effort in terms of usage, student feedback, and program impact to ensure the continued effectiveness and accessibility of the initiative for these communities; and,

THAT: In collaboration with LiveWell and campus partners, outreach and distribution efforts will intentionally include members of Panhellenic, National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC), and Multicultural Greek Council (MGC) organizations to ensure equitable access to wellness and harm reduction resources across the broader sorority and Greek community; and,

THAT: A copy of this bill be forwarded to Katie Ettl, LiveWell Student Needs Navigator; Marshall Traverse and Sara Thomas, SAO Advisors; Nandana Jaideep, ASUW President; Khushi Loomba, Finance and Budget Director; Trevor Hunt, Associate Director of HUB Finance & Business Operations.
