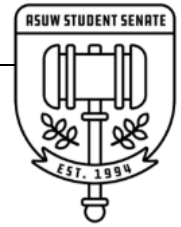

A Resolution to Endorse the Return of
Tent City 3 to Campus

BILL SUMMARY: Endorsing a letter distributed by Huskies for Housing that calls on the administration to invite the organized homeless encampment of Tent City Three back to UW's Campus.

- 1 **WHEREAS** Tent City Three (TC3) is a democratically run, sober
2 encampment of unhoused individuals [1]; and
- 3 **WHEREAS** Tent City Three is currently located in the Mt. Baker
4 neighborhood but moves around every few months [1]; and
- 5 **WHEREAS** Tent City Three has previously stayed on UW's campus
6 four times, most recently in the Winter Quarter of 2025, on the
7 parking lot next to Condon Hall [2]; and
- 8 **WHEREAS** That stay occurred without incident and allowed for
9 learning and community partnership opportunities between UW
10 students and the residents of TC3, adding to the UW learning
11 experience while helping UW's community [3]; and
- 12 **WHEREAS** Huskies for Housing (H4H) is an RSO dedicated to
13 supporting the local unhoused population that has been partnered
14 with TC3 in one form or another for over a decade and has
15 advocated to UW's administration to invite TC3 back to campus in
16 the past [4]; and
- 17 **WHEREAS** TC3's stays on UW's campus are generally safer than
18 other locations they have stayed [3]; and
- 19 **WHEREAS** TC3 has stayed on UW's campus every two years since
20 2021, and Winter Quarter of 2027 marks two years since their
21 last stay on UW's Campus [4]; and

22 **WHEREAS** H4H is now circulating a letter calling on UW's
23 administration to invite TC3 back to campus for Winter Quarter
24 of 2027, with consideration for extending the stay through
25 Spring Quarter [5];

26 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE**
27 **UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON:**

28 **THAT** the ASUW Senate, as the official opinion-making body of the
29 ASUW, formally endorse H4H's letter and calls upon UW
30 administrators to invite TC3 back to campus; and

31 **THAT** upon the UW administration's decision to invite TC3 back to
32 campus, all students be notified in an email no less than 3
33 months in advance about TC3's reintegration on campus and
34 location; and

35 **THAT** upon inviting TC3 back to campus, UW will hold a forum to
36 inform students about the presence of this community; and

37 **THAT** This legislation be sent to the following parties or
38 organizations by the ASUW Senate GAVEL Committee and the ASUW
