BOARD BILL 6.02 An Act to Commend Josue Villalobos for His Outstanding Service to ASUW and the University of Washington Community

WHEREAS: Josue began his ASUW journey as a Programming Intern during his first year at the University of Washington, demonstrating dedication, initiative, and leadership from the outset; and

WHEREAS: Since his time as an intern and now as a Director of the Latinx Student Commission, Josue has consistently fostered a safe, kind, and welcoming work environment, uplifting those around him and contributing to a culture rooted in care and collaboration; and

WHEREAS: Josue leads with compassion, integrity, and courage, modeling what it means to serve students with both strength and empathy, particularly in moments that require intentional advocacy and thoughtful leadership; and

WHEREAS: Throughout his involvement with ASUW, Josue has helped promote, execute, and lead impactful events at the University of Washington, strengthening student engagement and community connection; and

WHEREAS: On February 19, 2026, Josue and the Latin Student Commission hosted the “Know Your Rights” workshop in collaboration with over 30 campus groups and entities, demonstrating exceptional coordination, leadership, and commitment to student advocacy; and

WHEREAS: Through this workshop and his broader leadership, Josue has provided crucial resources to hundreds of University of Washington students, promoting safety, empowerment, connection, and kindness across campus; and

WHEREAS: It is vitally important that ASUW recognize and uplift leaders who create spaces of belonging, advocate for student wellbeing, and embody the values of community and service;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

THAT: The Board of Directors formally commends Josue for his outstanding leadership, dedication, and service to ASUW and the broader University of Washington community; and
