BOARD BILL 2.02: An Act to Appoint At-Large Members of the Judicial Committee

- 1) WHEREAS: Membership of the Judicial Committee includes at-large student representatives as outlined in the ASUW Constitution, Article XI, Section 2, Clause A, Sub-Clause 1-b, “Four students at-large selected for two year terms, staggered so that no more than two full-term appointments are made each ASUW session” [1]; and,
- 2) WHEREAS: As outlined in the ASUW Bylaws, Article I, Section 7, Clause J, Sub-Clause 1-i-1 the Director of Internal Policy shall appoint at-large student representatives to the Judicial Committee [2]; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- 1) THAT: Nardos Kidane, Sanjana Sivaraj, and Madisen Newbury be appointed for two-year terms through the 2025-2027 academic years; and,
- 2) THAT: Sejal Dogiparthi and Brian Kim be appointed for the remainder of the two-year terms through the 2025-2026 academic year; and,
- 3) THAT: Upon the approval from the Board of the Directors the ASUW President, Nandana Jaideep, shall forward this legislation to those listed below:
