Board Bill 3.05 – An Act to Fund the LiveWell & ASUW Start of the Year Health & Harm Reduction Initiative

WHEREAS the Associated Students of the University of Washington (ASUW) is committed to promoting student well-being and safety; and

WHEREAS the beginning of the year often involves increased social activity and experimentation among students, creating a greater need for harm reduction resources; and

WHEREAS providing students with accessible health supplies and educational materials can help mitigate health risks and promote informed decision-making; and

WHEREAS the Start of the Year Health & Harm Reduction Initiative aligns with ASUW’s mission to advocate for student wellness and enhance awareness of available resources; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

THAT: ASUW shall allocate **\$9,000** from the ASUW General Fund to support the Start of the Year Health & Harm Reduction Initiative, covering the costs of wellness kits, educational materials, and promotional efforts; and

THAT: the ASUW Director of Campus Partnerships shall oversee the implementation of this initiative in collaboration with LiveWell, UW Counseling Center, UW Husky Health, and other relevant student organizations; and

THAT: a copy of this bill be forwarded to Audriana Scott, ASUW Director of Campus Partnerships; Khushi Loomba, ASUW Finance and Budget Director; Nandana Jaideep, ASUW President; Jennifer Laxague, Assistant Director of Livewell; Sebastian Capp, Health Education Specialist.
