BOARD BILL 3.25: An Act to Allocate \$1,500 for OISA Programming

WHEREAS: The Associated Students of the University of Washington (ASUW) is committed to supporting commissions in expanding their constituent base; and,

WHEREAS: The Office of International Student Advocacy (OISA) has demonstrated motivation and tangible actions of increasing their student engagement through community-oriented and enjoyable events; and,

WHEREAS: OISA has seen a decrease in their programming budget compared to previous years; and,

WHEREAS: OISA has begun planning a concert featuring various student performers which requires funding beyond their allocated programming budget; and,

WHEREAS: The Director of Programming has been collaborating with OISA in developing a plan for this concert and will continue acting as a partner in the execution of this event; and,

WHEREAS: Granting funds of \$1,500 to OISA will allow the commission more flexibility in the events they plan this year and ensure that their programming budget will not run out of funding from hosting one event;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

THAT: The ASUW Board of Directors allocate \$1,500 from the General Fund to the Office of International Student Advocacy to go towards event planning initiatives; and,

THAT: This funding will be used at the discretion of the OISA Director and Assistant Director, in collaboration with the Director of Programming to ensure proper usage of funds for event planning; and,

THAT: A copy of this bill be forwarded to Renee Infelise, SAO Advisor; Grace Clarke, Director of Programming; Jenny Suwanchote, Office of International Student Advocacy Director; Nandana Jaideep, ASUW President; Khushi Loomba, Finance and Budget Director; Owen Rivera, Personnel Director; Trevor Hunt, Associate Director of HUB Finance & Business Operations.

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
