Board Bill 3.28 – An Act by ASUW to Fund the Purchase of Naloxone by the Husky Health Center

WHEREAS the Husky Health Center (HHC) is responsible for overseeing the provision of Naloxone across the University of Washington campus in compliance with Washington State law (HB 2112); and

WHEREAS the Husky Health Center’s monthly allotment of Naloxone from Public Health Seattle–King County has significantly decreased from approximately 100 to 200 boxes per month to only 30 boxes per month; and

WHEREAS the Husky Health Center has usage data from Lander, Oliver, the HUB and HHC Room 101 that shows ongoing need for approximately 100 boxes of Naloxone per month; and

WHEREAS the reduction in supplied Naloxone creates a shortfall of around 70 boxes per month, limiting the University’s ability to meet student health and safety needs; and

WHEREAS to meet campus demand for the next six months, the Husky Health Center must purchase approximately 420 additional Naloxone kits; and

WHEREAS the Husky Health Center will directly purchase the necessary Naloxone kits and store them at the Husky Health Center for campus-wide distribution, with funds allocated through this bill to be used to reimburse the Husky Health Center for these expenses; and

WHEREAS the total cost to purchase 420 Naloxone kits from Global Supply Exchange at a rate of \$29.50 per kit is \$12,390, with taxes bringing it to around \$13,600, making this a cost-effective and immediate solution to address the funding gap for the rest of this fiscal year; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

THAT: the ASUW shall allocate \$14,500 from the ASUW General Fund to support Husky Health Center in purchasing Naloxone through the FY26; and

THAT: the ASUW Director of Campus Partnerships shall oversee the implementation of this funding initiative in collaboration with the Husky Health Student Advisory Board chairs and the Husky Health Center administration; and

THAT: a copy of this bill be forwarded to Audriana Scott, ASUW Director of Campus Partnerships; Khushi Loomba, ASUW Finance and Budget Director; Trevor Hunt, Associate Director for Finance and Business Operation; Nandana Jaideep, ASUW President; Abigail Esther, Husky Health Student Advisory Board Co-Chair; Joel Schwartzkopf, Executive Director of Husky Health Center

This proposal details the Husky Health Center's (HHC) plan to increase the availability of funding for Naloxone across campus through FY26

Problem

1. HHC's allotment of Naloxone from the State/King County has drastically decreased from 100-200 boxes per month to only 30 from Public Health Seattle King County
2. Based on records of how much Naloxone is taken from Room 101 of the HHC and how much HHSAB board members distribute to Lander Hall, Oliver Hall, and the HUB Info Desk, we estimate a need of around 100 boxes of Naloxone per month
 - a. This means we need to fund 70 additional boxes of Narcan per month
3. UW has a legal requirement to provide Naloxone under HB2112 and the HHC has been tasked with overseeing this project
4. In order to meet student need for the next 6 months while HHC leadership works to permanently allocate budget funds to this initiative, we need to purchase approximately 420 additional boxes of Naloxone

Solution

1. Purchase 420 packs of Naloxone from [Global Supply Exchange](#) at a rate of \$29.50 per kit for a total cost of \$12,390, with taxes coming to around \$13,600
