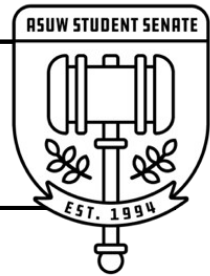

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**SENATE RESOLUTION R-31-29**

A Resolution in Support of the Installation  
of a Dawg Prints Printer in Poplar Hall.

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Under Consideration - 2024-2025 Academic Year

1 **WHEREAS** the first floor of Poplar Hall is already open to all UW  
2 residence hall students for use of the Learning Resource Center;  
3 and

4 **WHEREAS** there is no functioning printer currently in any West  
5 Campus residence hall, with little accurate information on where  
6 to find the closest available printers; and

7 **WHEREAS** the only functioning printer on North campus that is  
8 available for resident and non-resident use is in Spratlan Hall;  
9 and

10 **WHEREAS** the installation of a printer would incentivize public  
11 use of the West Campus Learning Resource Center, which has  
12 historically had less utilization than its North Campus  
13 counterpart [a]; and

14 **WHEREAS** the average cost of a DAWG Prints printer is  
15 approximately \$100-\$200, which is a low-cost relative to total  
16 STF revenue [1]; and

17 **WHEREAS** DAWG Prints holds several printers in storage in  
18 preparation for possible installation in different areas across  
19 campus, meaning that the installation of a printer in Poplar may  
20 require no additional purchase; and

21 **WHEREAS** the investment in a DAWG Prints printer in Poplar Hall,  
22 because payment is required for use like all other printers  
23 across campus, would increase revenue by expanding accessibility  
24 of printer access to more residents [2]; and

25 **WHEREAS** the Residence Halls on West campus all advertise  
26 throughout the building that the nearest printer is located in  
27 Alder Hall, when in reality Alder Hall's printer has been  
28 removed due to vandalism for the entire year with no attempts to  
29 inform or communicate with the residents on West campus; and

30 **WHEREAS** Poplar Hall used to have a printer in their Residence  
31 Hall, but it was removed in 2023 due to vandalism, with the  
32 intention of re-locating it to the LRC where it can be more  
33 closely monitored; and

34 **WHEREAS** this project was pushed to the bottom of the priority  
35 list, leading Poplar Hall to have no accessible printer for  
36 multiple years; and

37 **WHEREAS** a university student should not be tasked with a long  
38 walk across campus to find something as necessary as a printer;  
39 and

40 **WHEREAS** students feel unsafe at night and the extensive walk to  
41 alternative printer locations is inconvenient and potentially  
42 dangerous for West Campus students; and

43 **WHEREAS** many buildings are closed during certain times of the  
44 day, while Poplar Hall and the LRC do not close, allowing  
45 accessibility for students at all hours;

46 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE**  
47 **UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON:**

48 **THAT** the Student Technology Fee program funds the installation  
49 of a DAWG Prints printer in the Learning Resource Center of  
50 Poplar Hall; and

51 **THAT** Housing and Food Services lists an accessible printer as an  
52 amenity for Poplar Hall on their housing website [5]; and

53 **THAT** Poplar Hall makes efforts towards the advertisement of this  
54 addition, such as social media posts and posters throughout the  
55 building [6]; and

56 **THAT** Poplar Hall's Learning Resource Center be listed as a  
57 location for a DAWG Prints printer on the DAWG Prints website  
58 [4]; and

59 **THAT** measures to inform students of this additional printer be  
60 taken by residence halls across West Campus, such as posters,  
61 | informational emails, etc.; **and**

62 | **THAT measures to remove false or misleading information about**  
63 **the Alder Printer be taken by Housing and Food Services;** and

64 | **THAT Dawg Prints commits to ensuring continued access to a**  
65 **printer in West Campus in the event of a future act of vandalism**  
66 **of a printer;** and

67 | **THAT the Residential Life Office** readily **accept the role of**  
68 **handling errors and maintenance with this new printer,** and allow  
69 students to report difficulties by utilizing the Work Order form  
70 on the Building Resources Website [7]; and

71 **THAT** a copy of this legislation be forwarded to the following

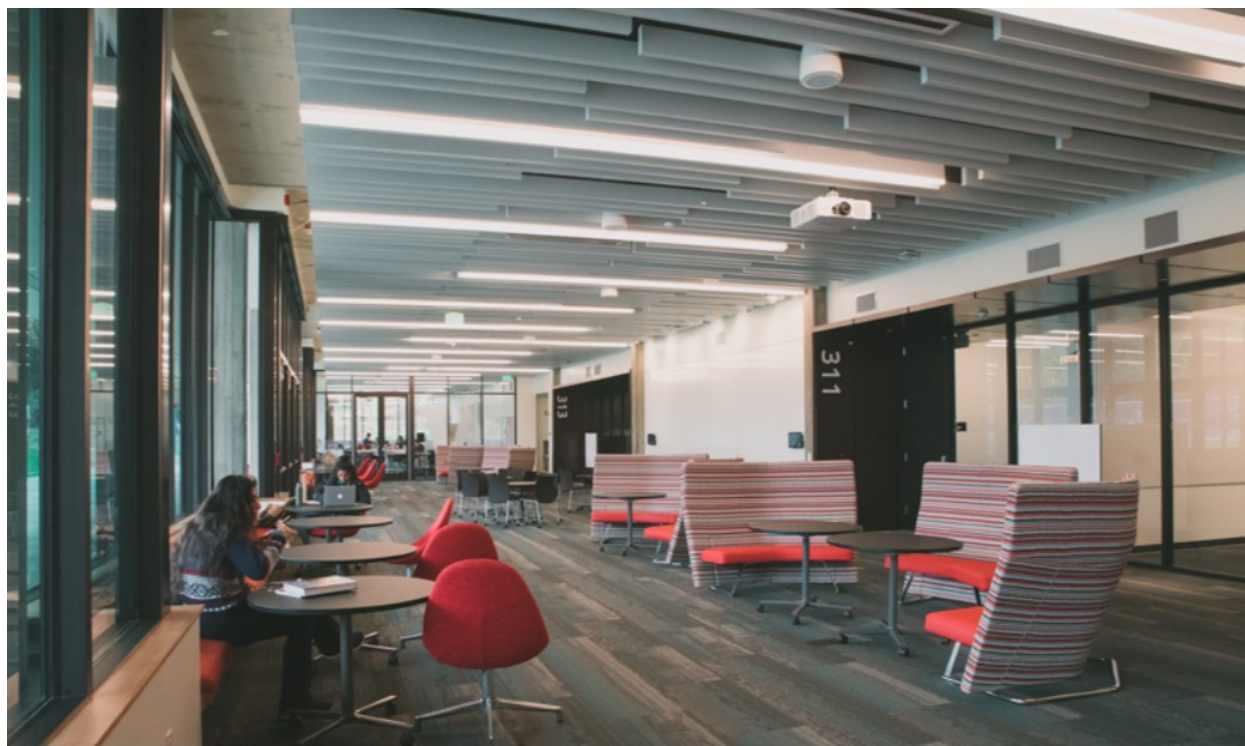
